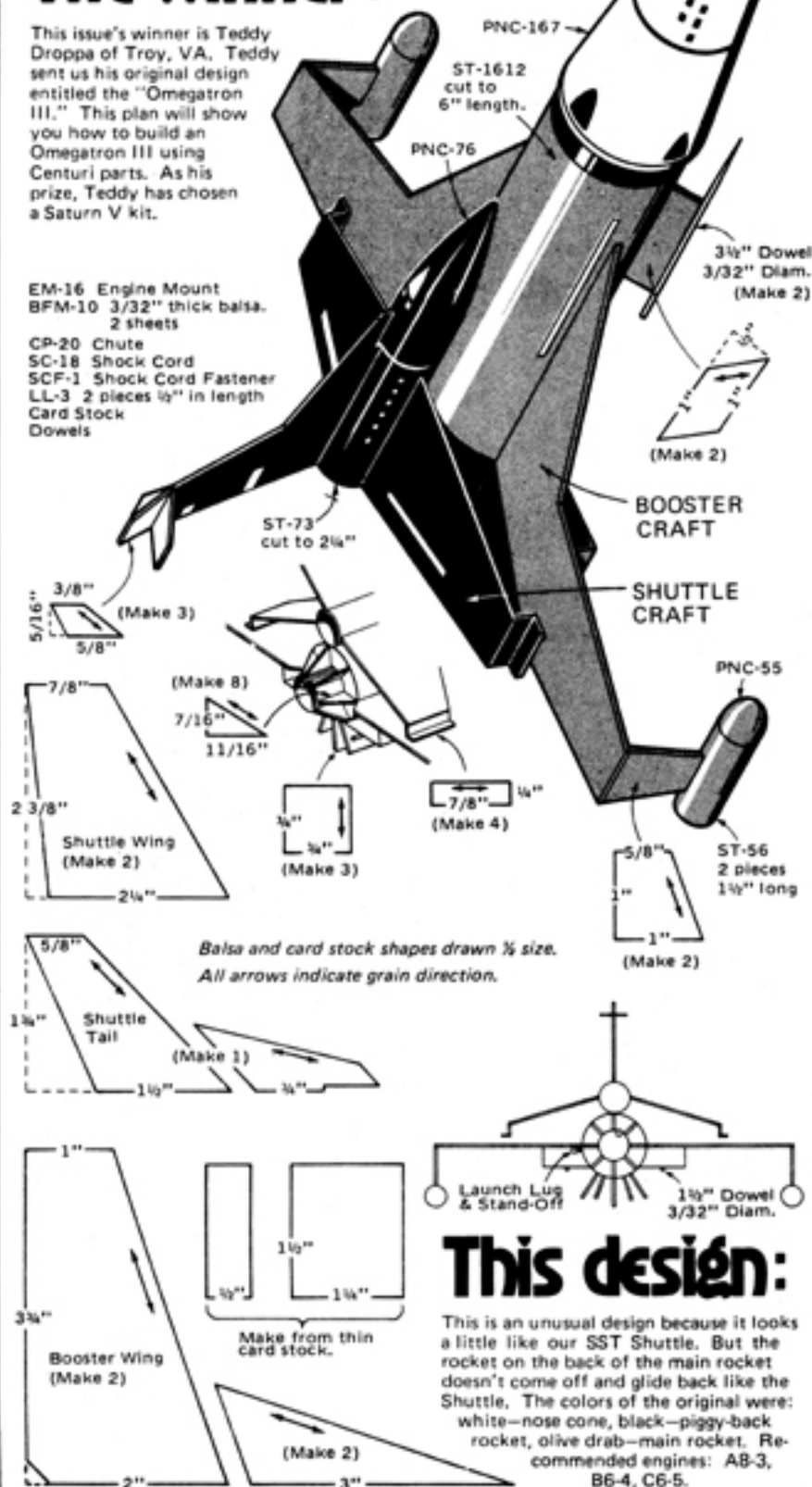


# Design Contest

## The winner:

This issue's winner is Teddy Droppa of Troy, VA. Teddy sent us his original design entitled the "Omegatron III." This plan will show you how to build an Omegatron III using Centuri parts. As his prize, Teddy has chosen a Saturn V kit.

- EM-16 Engine Mount
- BFM-10 3/32" thick balsa, 2 sheets
- CP-20 Chute
- SC-18 Shock Cord
- SCF-1 Shock Cord Fastener
- LL-3 2 pieces 1/2" in length
- Card Stock
- Dowels



## This design:

This is an unusual design because it looks a little like our SST Shuttle. But the rocket on the back of the main rocket doesn't come off and glide back like the Shuttle. The colors of the original were: white—nose cone, black—piggy-back rocket, olive drab—main rocket. Recommended engines: AB-3, B6-4, C6-5.
